The Board then considered the payment of District bills. Upon motion made by Director Brown, seconded by Director Goodman and unanimously carried, the Board approved payment of the District's bills.

The Board discussed damage to a restroom on District park property, noting two bids for cleanup of vegetation surrounding the facility. After discussion, the Board tabled the matter to adjust the scope of services.

The District maintained 975 connections and accounted for 93% of water produced. The Board then discussed recent repairs generally. Upon motion made by Director Brown, seconded by Director Vandever and unanimously carried, the Board approved the operator's report as presented.

EIGHTH ORDER: ENGINEER'S REPORT

The Board recognized Taylor Reed who presented the engineer's report. The Board reviewed the report in detail. The engineer discussed updates with respect to permitting, design projects, and construction projects. Further, the engineer requested approval for the invoice in the amount of

The Board then discussed District projects.
