

Fort Dodge Choral Society
Scholarships Award Program, 1998-99 to present
(last updated July 2025)

In order to support students pursuing careers in vocal music, a committee was formed in 1997 to develop, in consultation with the Board, a set of guidelines for awarding scholarships. Since that time, scholarships have been awarded to undergraduate college students majoring in a music field with vocal emphasis.

Recipients must be undergraduates with college sophomore status by the award year, and either:

- attending an Iowa college/university, **OR**
- from the Fort Dodge area, attending any college or university.

In 2003, a stipulation was added that a person can be awarded the scholarship a total of two times.

Our scholarship program began with the 1998-99 school year. Scholarships then were \$500; they increased to \$1,000 in 2015. In July 2025, the Board voted to increase scholarships to \$1,500, beginning in the 2026-2027 school year. Funds for scholarships are derived from money budgeted each year from the regular budget and from separate scholarship funds to which anyone may contribute.

In 2019, an additional funding source for scholarships was established through the Fort Dodge Community Foundation and United Way, titled The Fort Dodge Choral Society Collegiate Singers Fund. Annually, after FDCS awards a scholarship from the general budget (funds raised during the annual membership drive), an additional scholarship may be awarded from The Collegiate Singers Fund, if there are sufficient funds. Also, FDCS often receives gifts in memory of former singers; these memorial gifts are sometimes specifically donated to fund FDCS scholarships. Music performances are occasionally organized to raise funds for FDCS scholarships.

We know that these scholarships help encourage young men and women to keep singing throughout their lives, in their communities and often as part of their professional work. Our 2012 scholarship recipient, Jessica Ann Faselt, went on to win the 2018 Metropolitan Opera National Council Auditions in New York. Several scholarship recipients have returned to sing with FDCS later in life.
