

Fort Dodge Choral Society
Scholarships Award Program, 1998-99 to present
(last updated 5.15.24)

In order to support students pursuing careers in vocal music, a committee was formed in 1997 to develop, in consultation with the Board, a set of guidelines for awarding scholarships. Since that time, scholarships have been awarded to undergraduate college students majoring in a music field with vocal emphasis. Recipients must be undergraduates with college sophomore status by the award year. Recipients must be attending an Iowa college/university or be from the Fort Dodge area attending any college or university. In 2003, a stipulation was added that a person can be awarded the scholarship a total of two times.

“Beginning with the 1998-99 school year, 51 scholarships have been awarded to 40 students. Currently, Scholarships are \$1000, having increased from \$500 in 2015. A total of \$27,850 have been awarded to date. Funds for scholarships area derived from money budgeted each year and from a special scholarship fund to which anyone may contribute.”

Further developments in funding:

In 2019, an additional funding source for scholarships was established through the Greater Fort Dodge and United Way Community Foundation, titled The Fort Dodge Choral Society Collegiate Singers Fund. Annually, after FDCS awards a scholarship from the general budget (funds raised during the annual membership drive), an additional scholarship may be awarded from The Collegiate Singers Fund. After that, if needed, an additional third scholarship can be awarded from The Collegiate Singers Fund. Anyone can donate to that fund.

FDCS often receives gifts in memory of former singers; these memorial gifts are often specifically donated to fund FDCS scholarships. In several instances music performances have been organized to raise funds for FDCS scholarships.
