

Disclaimer and Restrictions

Bethalto Chamber of Commerce Cash Raffle

Bethalto Chamber of Commerce Cash Raffle will benefit the Bethalto Sports Complex.

1. The purchase price for one (1) raffle ticket is \$100. Only 300 tickets will be sold.
2. ELIGIBILITY TO ENTER: Raffle tickets may be purchased ONLY BY INDIVIDUAL PERSONS WHO ARE EIGHTEEN (18) YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER as of the date of purchase.
3. Tickets may be purchased with a check, cash, or credit card. If an entrants check is returned unpaid by the bank, the entry ticket(s) will be invalid unless a cash payment is received by BCC by August 31st the official raffle deadline.
4. All ticket entry purchases are final and non-refundable unless ordered by the BCC. The BCC reserves the right to cancel the raffle and refund ticket purchases in the event that ticket sales are deemed insufficient. Ticket drawing date may be extended at the Chambers discretion.
5. Entrant will retain the original printed raffle ticket. The stub will be entered into the drawing and will be retained by BCC. If purchased online, the raffle ticket will be mailed to the address provided by the Entrant at the time of sale and BCC will retain the stub.
6. All unsold tickets and proceeds from the raffle ticket sales must be received by BCC no later than August 31. If received after the official deadline, all monies will be returned to the entrant(s) and associated tickets will be invalid.
7. The winner of the raffle will be determined by a random drawing. The drawing will take place on Saturday, September 3rd, at approximately 12:00 p.m. CST at the Bethalto Labor Day Homecoming. You do not need to be present to win. A video of this drawing will be posted online on the BCC Facebook page.
8. Winners agree to comply with all IRS regulations regarding raffle winnings.
9. The winner of the BCC Raffle must claim the prize within seven (7) days of the drawing. If the winner does not claim the prize within 7 days by responding to phone or written notice by BCC or otherwise, the prize will be forfeited, and a second drawing will take place.
10. Purchasers of the raffle tickets must legibly write their full legal name, address, e-mail, and telephone number on each individual ticket stub. If there is more than one name on the ticket stub, the first listed name shall be the Entrant. BCC will have no obligation for payment or delivery of any prize to any person other than the Entrant. It is the sole responsibility of the entrant to allocate any such prize among participants in any multiple party entry.
11. ALL METHODS OF PURCHASE MAY NOT BE AVAILABLE AT ALL TIMES. The Bethalto Chamber of Commerce may suspend or stop the sale of Raffle tickets at any time at its sole discretion. THE RAFFLE IS VOID WHEREVER PROHIBITED BY LAW
12. By participating in the Raffle, each participant agrees the Released Parties, as defined below, will have no liability whatsoever for, and shall be indemnified, released, and held harmless by each participant against, any liability for injuries, losses, costs, expenses or damages of any kind, including damages for death, personal injury, property damage or property loss, resulting from, whether in whole

or in part or directly or indirectly, participation in this Raffle or the acceptance, possession, misuse or use of any Raffle ticket or prize. "Released Parties" means The Bethalto Chamber of Commerce, any third-party payment processor involved in the Raffle, and all chamber board members. BCC makes no express or implied warranty as to the Raffle Prize.

13. Raffle Tickets are NOT transferable.

14. Raffle is void where prohibited.

15. Winners agree to allow BCC to publish their names and photographs on the BCC website and Facebook page.

GOVERNING LAW; SEVERABILITY; WAIVER: The Raffle and these Official Rules shall be subject to and governed by the laws of the State of Illinois. If a court of competent jurisdiction finds any term, condition, or provision of these Official Rules, or their application to particular persons or circumstances, is invalid, unlawful, or unenforceable to any extent, then such term, condition, or provision shall be deemed to be restated to reflect as nearly as possible the original intentions of the Official Rules in accordance with applicable law and the remainder of these Official Rules, and the application of all of these Official Rules to other persons or circumstances, shall not be affected by such determination, and shall remain enforceable to the fullest extent permitted by law. The failure of BCC to enforce at any time any provision of the Official Rules shall not be considered a waiver of such provision or any other provision and shall not deprive BCC of the right thereafter to enforce such provision or any other provision.

MANDATORY ARBITRATION AGREEMENT; CLASS ACTION WAIVER: Any claim, other than a claim by BCC, that is not resolved informally must be resolved in accordance with the below arbitration provisions. Unless prohibited by federal law, each purchaser of a Raffle ticket (any such individual, "Purchaser"), including, without limitation, any winner of a Raffle, agrees to arbitrate any and all claims and disputes relating in any way to such purchase or the selection of a winner or delivery or awarding of the Prize ("Arbitration Claims"), except for Arbitration Claims concerning the validity, scope or enforceability of this arbitration provision, through **BINDING INDIVIDUAL ARBITRATION**. This Arbitration Agreement involves interstate commerce and shall be governed by the Federal Arbitration Act, 9 U.S.C. §§ 1-16 ("FAA"), and not by state law.

In any Arbitration Claim to be resolved by arbitration, neither of Purchaser or BCC will be able to have a court or jury trial or participate in a class action or class arbitration. Other rights that Purchaser and BCC would have in court will not be available or will be more limited in arbitration, including the right to appeal. **Purchaser WAIVES THE RIGHT TO A COURT OR JURY TRIAL. ALL DISPUTES SHALL BE ARBITRATED ON AN INDIVIDUAL BASIS, AND NOT AS A CLASS ACTION, REPRESENTATIVE ACTION, CLASS ARBITRATION, OR ANY SIMILAR PROCEEDING.** The arbitrator(s) may not consolidate the claims of multiple parties.
