



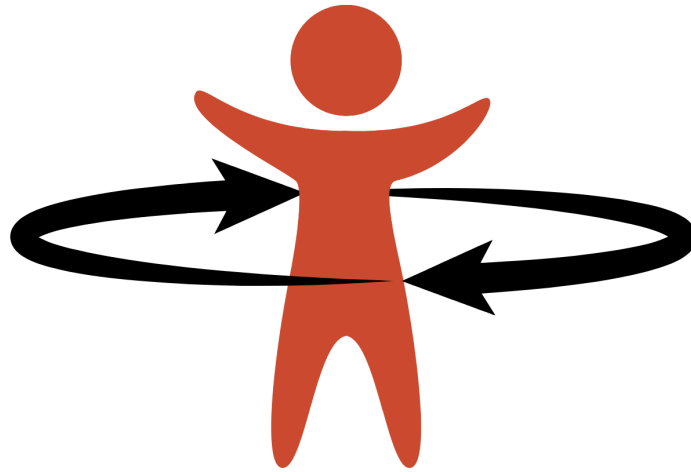

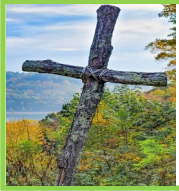

## Sloan Chapman Elected to Executive Board

In a recent meeting the Lighthouse Christian Camp Executive Board unanimously voted to invite Sloan Chapman to be a member of the Board of Directors. Sloan is the son of Bro. Ben and Ermeda Chapman, the founders of Lighthouse Christian Camp, Inc., (a 501(c)(3) nonprofit corporation).

Sloan was (7) years old when the camp was founded in 1982. He has worked in every capacity at the camp through his childhood, teen years and as an adult. Sloan worked alongside his dad doing every aspect of construction and maintenance. Most of the stone work throughout the camp was done by Sloan.

As a 10-year-old he ran the snack bar, and later was a lifeguard, counselor and staff member.

Ashleigh Sheldon came as a counselor in the summer of 1998 and served on staff in the following years. Ashleigh and Sloan were married in February 2001 and moved into the home Sloan had constructed adjacent to the camp property.

Ashleigh and Sloan served as camp directors until Ashleigh enrolled in Regent Law School in 2009. They moved to Virginia Beach, Virginia, and Ashleigh graduated with honors in 2013 and founded the Alliance for Freedom Restoration and Justice. The Alliance is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit, global humanitarian aid organization to end human trafficking and to protect the vulnerable.

Ashleigh and Sloan currently reside in Laramie, Wyoming.

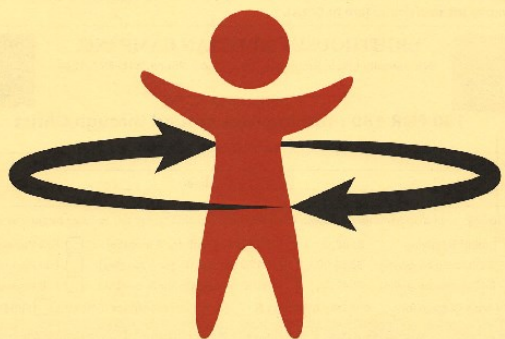

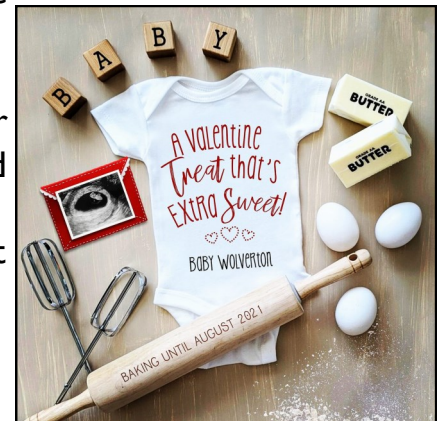

In 2019, Joan had an accident where she fell and broke her pelvis. This time of healing caused her to slow down and reflect on what God might have in store for her. Joan was desiring to find ways to serve God in her life and earnestly sought His guidance, eventually opening her up to the idea of moving away from Ohio (now that her grandchildren were grown and involved with their own lives).
