A word from Dustin Danilaitis:

This was my first year serving at Lighthouse Christian Camp, and honestly, I had no idea what to expect. Coming into camp, my prayer life and Bible reading were not consistent, and it showed during week one of boys' camp. By Tuesday afternoon, I was done and wanted to go home. Then my buddy encouraged me to pray. That evening, I prayed and dove into God's Word, and felt encouraged. I want to encourage whoever is reading this to lean into God and trust in Him. Pray about whatever you are facing and give it to God because He wants to hear from His children. But also read your Bible. Learn your Bible so when Satan comes to you, you can say, "Well, actually, the Bible did not say that." The Bible is an instruction manual for our lives, and we should desire to read it daily.

The other lesson I learned at camp is to trust in God's timing. Ecclesiastes 3 tells us there is a time for everything. We should not doubt God when life gets hard but continually praise and worship Him. You may be in a trial for a reason, and later you could use that experience to pour into someone else going through the same season. I learned so much about God this summer, but these two lessons stand out the most: pray without ceasing and trust in His plan for your life.

We are so excited to begin what God has laid on our hearts: the construction of what we are currently calling Camp 3! The new campsite will be within walking distance of the dining hall, reducing travel time, increasing safety and security, and bringing about the unification of Camp 1 and Camp 2. The picture below is a digital rendering of what the new campsite may look like.

The new camp area will be able to house 50–60 campers, with three duplex cabins featuring bathrooms and showers inside each cabin. There will also be a staff cabin to house volunteers and lead staff, as well as a meeting area for prayer and morning meetings. We are envisioning a large chapel area integrated into the hillside, a covered pavilion for activities, and a fire pit with seating around it.

The legacy of obedience to God that Bro. Ben left is still carried on today. We are trusting that God will provide every need for this project because He has told us to do it! Just like every other project at Lighthouse, no loans will be taken out; God will provide by prompting His people to financially support what His plan is.
