Having enough volunteers for Lighthouse events can be difficult. For the Christmas parties people are needed to serve as store clerks behind the tables and in clothing areas. Even more are needed in gift wrapping, Christmas Caroling, hot chocolate serving and more.

Often we adults get so busy with life that we don't feel like we have a week to spend at camp in the summer or a day to give for one of the Christmas Parties. The result is that the children who attend don't always get that one-on-one attention and love that God wants them to receive. This year was different! In more than 30 years of Christmas parties Lighthouse has rarely seen more than 175 volunteers. For the girls party on December 2<sup>nd</sup> God sent **292** volunteers to minister to and love on the children. On the following Saturday of the boys party when volunteer numbers are normally drastically down God sent another **233** of His people to serve. Praise His Holy name!

**With the abundance of volunteers we were able to create a new position of "Personal Shopper" where each child had a volunteer come alongside of them, carry their bag and help them choose gifts from the tables. This close and personal teaming up of volunteers and campers made many precious memories for all involved.**

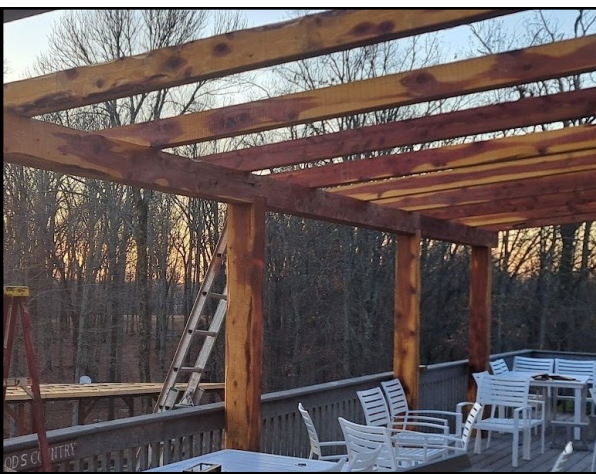




# Dining Hall Gets A New Covered Porch

Our prayer for you is that our Lord would richly bless you in the New Year!

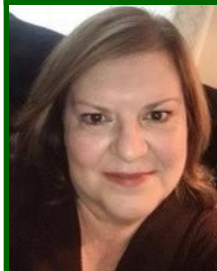

## PRAYING FOR PROVISIONS AND LABORERS AS NEW WIDOWS HOME PROGRESSES



200 Joy Lane is well under construction. The basement walls are up, the block filled with concrete and the foundation is ready for the framing to begin.

As we contemplate the next steps in the process we are getting quotes for framing lumber, floor and roof trusses, exterior doors and windows and other items required to get the walls up and sheeted, the roof on and to get the building "dried in."

Please pray along with us for God to put it on the hearts of suppliers to discount needed materials so that dollars are stretched.

Once framing has started it will be crucial to get it under roof as soon as possible. A good

"professional" framing crew can do this in just one to two days. Although we try to do as much of the labor as possible it will take us much longer to complete. We are therefore diligently praying that a local home builder and/or framing crew will be moved to donate or heavily discount the framing and drying in of the home. With this done we will be able to work through the winter on plumbing, electrical and more.
