Once again over 800 under-resourced, disadvantaged and often needy children are expected to attend our annual Christmas Parties on December 3rd & 10th.

People from all across our communities, state and even country purchase and send or deliver the thousands of gifts needed for the parties. Others give financially to purchase the gifts, and provide for the fruit and candy that are placed under the tree for every child. There are also those that give funds to purchase supplies, food, and drinks.

As the excited children arrive the chaos begins! Groups of 80 or so children along with several counselors rotate to different stations throughout the day. They sing Christmas carols and drink hot chocolate, listen to "the real" story of Christmas, eat lunch and of course shop. You may think that they only shop for themselves but that's rarely the case. They can't wait to take home a gift basket for mom or a warm winter coat to a sibling who doesn't have one.
