Genesis 12:2-3 ERV

[From God to Abram] "I will build a great nation from you. I will bless you and make your name famous. People will use your name to bless other people. I will bless those who bless you, and I will curse those who curse you. I will use **you** to bless all the people on earth."

2,000 years after Adam, 500 years after Great Flood, Abram came to Canaan.... God promised the land to Abram and his descendents. The mud/clay gate at the lower left is from the time of Abram. After the Flood, in 200 years could have easily had 20 million people or more on the earth. At 75 years old, Abram traveled to Canaan with his family. 25 years later had Isaac with Sarah. At age 40, Isaac married **Rebekah**, and at age 60, had Jacob and Esau. Thru Joseph and famine, God sends Jacob and his family of 70 to Egypt. After 400 years, the Israelites become millions in Egypt. God thru Moses rescued Israelites, and thru Jacob conquer land of Canaan. 500 years of Judges from Othniel to Samuel. Kings Saul, David, Solomon, etc. 1,000 years. Jesus and destruction of Jerusalem 70 A.D. And again in 135 A.D. Hadrian renamed Israel "Syria Palaestina" after Philistines. Renamed Jerusalem to "Aelia Capitolina." After Romans left, and Constantine became Christian, city named back to Jerusalem in 324 A.D. Christian city. Muslims conquered in 638 A.D. Eight Crusades by Europeans between 1100 and 1300. 25 crusades by Muslims. Fort walls rebuilt around 1540. Jews started emigrating in 1880's. Balfour declaration in 1917. England took control after World War 1. Jews accepted United Nations Resolution in 1948. War for about a year. Jordan controlled half of Jerusalem, and West Bank. Became Jordanian citizens. In 6-day war in 1967, Israel won, and controlled Sinai penninsula, Gaza, West Bank, Golan Heights. Land for peace. Arafat intifada. Gaza in 2005. Portions of WB given autonomy. Only 200,000 to 300,000 Arabs from Crusades to 1800's in Israel. Today: 2 million. Israel total about 9.5 million.
