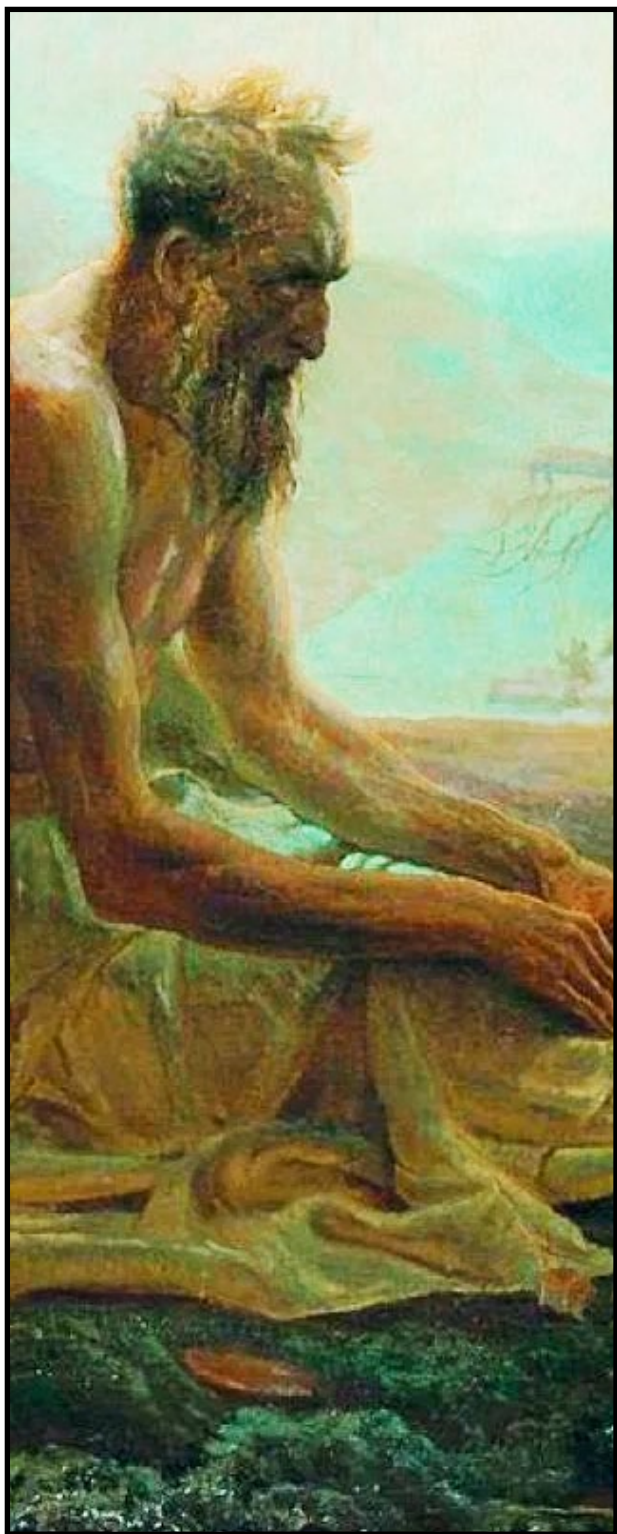

Job 1:1 ESV

“In the land of Uz there lived a man whose name was Job. This man was **blameless** and upright; he feared God and shunned **evil**.”

Where was the land of Uz?

The first of the raiding parties were **Sabeans**. (Job 1:15)

The second of the raiding parties were **Chaldeans**. (Job 1:17)

One of Job’s friends was from Teman, in Edom (close to Petra). (See Lam 4:21.)

His friend Bildad was a Shuite, and Shuah was a son of **Abraham**. (See Gen. 25:2)

Younger guy Elihu was a Buzite, Buz also a descendent of Abraham.” (Job 32:2)
