## When God will not hear



### Isaiah 59:1-2 AMP

“Behold, the Lord’s hand is not so short that it cannot **save**, nor His ear so impaired that it cannot **hear**. But your wickedness has separated you from your God, and your sins have hidden His face from you so that He does not hear.”

### Psalms 94:8-11 ESV

“Understand, O dullest of the people! Fools, when will you be wise? He who planted the **ear**, does He not **hear**? He who formed the **eye**, does He not **see**? He who disciplines the nations, does He not rebuke? He who teaches man knowledge—the Lord—KNOWS the **thoughts** of man, that they are but a breath.”

### Psalms 139:2 VOICE

“You even know the small **details**, like when I take a seat and when I stand up again. Even when I am far away, You know what I’m thinking.”

### Psalms 37:23 NLT

“The steps of the godly are directed by the Lord. He **delights** in every detail of their lives.”

### John 15:7 ESV

“If you **abide** in Me, and My words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you.”

### 1 Peter 3:7 NLT+

“In the same way, you husbands MUST give **HONOR** to your wives. Treat your wife with understanding as you live together. She may be [physically] weaker than you are, but she IS your **equal** partner in God’s gift of new life. So, husbands, treat her as you SHOULD, so that YOUR **prayers** will not be blocked, or rendered ineffective.”

You **fasted** and wept for the child while he was alive; but when the child died, you arose and ate food.’ And David said, ‘While the child was still alive, I fasted and wept, for I said, “Who knows whether the Lord will be **gracious** to me, that the child may live?” But now he is dead. Why should I fast? Can I bring him back again? I shall go to him, but he will not return to me.’”
