John 10:24-25 AMP

So the Jews surrounded Him and began saying to Him, “How long are You going to keep us in **suspense**? If You are [really] the Christ (the Messiah, the Anointed One), tell us so plainly and openly.” Jesus answered them, “I have told you so, yet you do not believe. The works that I do in My Father’s name **testify** concerning Me [they are My credentials and the evidence declaring who I am].”

Nebuchadnezzar.....commanded that the **furnace** be heated seven times hotter than usual.....they tied them up and threw them into the furnace, fully dressed in their pants, turbans, robes, and other garments. And because the king, in his anger, had demanded such a hot fire in the furnace, the flames **killed** the soldiers as they threw the three men in..... “Look!” Nebuchadnezzar shouted. “I see four men, unbound, walking around in the fire unharmed! And the fourth looks like a god!”.... Then the high officers, officials, governors, and advisers crowded around them and saw that the fire had not **touched** them. Not a hair on their heads was singed, and their clothing was not scorched. They didn’t even smell of smoke!

And a great windstorm arose, and the waves were breaking into the boat, so that the boat was already filling.....and [Jesus] awoke and **rebuked** the wind and said to the sea, “**Peace!
