## 2 Samuel 5:17,19b-20, 6:1-2, 12b-14 NLT

"When the Philistines heard that David had been anointed king of Israel, they mobilized all their forces to capture him. But David was told they were coming, so he went out of the city to a strong, safe place [and prayed].....The Lord replied to David, 'Yes, go ahead. I will certainly hand them over to you.' So David went to Baal-perazim and defeated the Philistines there. 'The Lord did it!' David exclaimed. 'He burst through my enemies like a raging flood!' So he named that place Baal-perazim (which means 'the Lord who bursts through')....Then David brought the Ark of God from the house of Obed-edom to the City of David with a great celebration. After the men who were carrying the Ark of the Lord had gone six steps, David sacrificed a bull and a fattened calf. And David before the Lord with all his might, wearing a priestly garment."

#### 1 Kings 18:24,26,29-30,36,38-40; 19:1-3a ICB

"'You prophets of Baal, pray to your god. And I will pray to the Lord. The god who answers the prayer will set fire to his wood. He is the true God.' All the people agreed that this was a good idea....So they took the bull that was given to them and prepared it. They prayed to Baal from morning until noon. They shouted, 'Baal, answer us!' But there was no sound. No one answered. They danced around the altar they had built....The afternoon passed, and the prophets continued to act wildly....But no voice was heard. Baal did not answer.... Then Elijah said to all the people, 'Now come to me.' So they gathered around him. Elijah sacrifice. So the prophet Elijah went near the altar. He prayed, 'Lord, you are the God of Abraham, Isaac and Israel. I ask you now to prove that you are the God of Israel. And prove that I am your servant'.... Then fire from the Lord came down. It burned the sacrifice, the wood, the stones and the ground around the altar. It also dried up the water in the ditch. When all the people saw this, they fell down to the ground. They cried, 'The Lord is God! The Lord is God!' Elijah gave instruction for them to be taken to the Kishon Valley and killed immediately—no exceptions.....King Ahab told Jezebel everything Elijah had done. Ahab told her how Elijah had killed all the prophets [850] with a sword. So Jezebel sent a messenger to Elijah. Jezebel said, 'By this time tomorrow I will kill you. I will kill you as you killed those prophets. If I don't succeed, may the gods punish me terribly.' When Elijah heard this, he was afraid. So he ran away to save his life."

#### Exodus 14:29-31: 15:1,20-21 ICB

"But the people of Israel crossed the sea on dry land. There was a **wall** of water on their right and on their left. So that day the Lord saved the Israelites from the Egyptians. And the Israelites saw the Egyptians lying dead on the seashore. When the people of Israel saw the great power that the Lord had used against the Egyptians, they feared the Lord. And they trusted the Lord and his servant Moses....Then Moses and the Israelites sang this song to the Lord: I will sing to the Lord because He is worthy of great honor.
