Colossian 1:22-23a AMP

"Yet Christ has now reconciled you [to God] in His physical body through death, in order to present you before the Father holy and **blameless** and beyond reproach— [and He will do this] if you continue in the faith, well-grounded and steadfast, and not shifting away from the [confident] **hope** [that is a result] of the Gospel that you have heard...."

Matthew 5:24 NLT+

[*diallasso*] "So if you are standing before the altar in the Temple, offering a sacrifice to God, and you suddenly remember that **someone** has something against you, LEAVE your sacrifice there, beside the altar. Go and be **reconciled** to that person. Then come and offer your sacrifice to God."

2 Corinthians 5:19a,21 NIV

[*apokatalasso*] "God was in Christ. He was working through Christ to bring the whole world back to **Himself**. God no longer held men's sins against them.... Christ never sinned but God put our sin on Him. Then we are made right with God because of what Christ has done for us."

Ephesians 1:4 NLV/AMP

"Even before the world was made, God chose us for Himself because of His love. He **planned** that we should be **holy** [that is, consecrated, set apart for Him, purpose-driven] and *blameless in His sight*."

1 Peter 1:18-19 NLT [LEGAL GUILT]

"For you know that God paid a RANSOM to **rescue** you from the empty life you inherited from your ancestors. And the ransom HE paid, was not mere gold or silver. But rather, it was THE precious **blood** of the Christ, THE sinless, spotless Lamb of God."

2 Corinthians 7:9-10a NLV [EMOTIONAL GUILT]

"Now I am glad I sent [the letter], not because it hurt you, but because the pain caused you to **repent** and change your ways. It was the kind of **sorrow** God wants His people to have, so that you were not [actually] harmed by us in any way. [No, this is] the kind of sorrow God wants us to experience, because it leads us **AWAY** from sin and results in our salvation. There's no regret for that kind of sorrow."

Colossians 2:13 ICB ▶ [something which happens at a point in time that doesn't need repeating]

"You were spiritually **dead** because of your sins and because you were not free from the power of your sinful self. But God made you alive with Christ. And God **FORGAVE** [or 'has forgiven'] **ALL** our sins."

1 John 1:9 AMP [literal translation of the Greek tenses]

"If we *keep on confessing* our sins, He is **faithful** and just [true to His own nature and promises], *to have forgiven us* of our sins and *to have cleansed us* continually from everything in us not in conformity with His will and purpose."

Hebrews 7:24b-25 NLT

"Because **Jesus** lives forever, His priesthood lasts forever. Therefore He is able, **once** and forever, to save those who come to God through Him. He lives forever to **intercede** with God on their behalf."
