Fear: a good thing, or a bad thing?



SIX different kinds fear:

1) Fear of natural things (bears, storms, bugs, mice, etc.)
2) Fear of uncontrollable situations (heights, bridges, elevators, etc.)
3) Fear of other people (bullies, relatives, homeless, police, etc.)
4) Fear of self inadequacies (failure, appearance, getting old, financial worth, etc.)
5) Fear of deserved punishment (from a parent, a boss, a spouse, an owner, etc.)
6) Fear of God
