John 18:37-38 ^{LSB} “Therefore Pilate said to Him, “So You are a king?” Jesus answered, “You yourself said I am a king. For this I have been born, and for this I have come into the world, to bear witness to the truth. Everyone who is of the truth hears My voice.” Pilate said to Him, “What is truth?”

Absolutes

(Egyptians used the diameter of a water drop as a standard.)



Genesis 6:15-16 ^{LSB}

“Now this is how you shall make it: the **length** of the ark 300 cubits, its breadth 50 cubits, and its height 30 cubits. You shall make a **window** for the ark, and complete it to one cubit from the top; and set the door of the ark in the side of it; you shall make it with lower, second, and third decks.”

The Ark Encounter used an Egyptian cubit = 20.6 inches.

So their Ark is approximately 515 feet long by 86 feet wide by 52 feet tall.

Psalms 24:10 ^{AMP}

“Who is [He then] this King of **glory**? The Lord of hosts, HE IS the King of glory [who rules over all creation with His heavenly armies].”

[According to AI: The glory of God refers to the manifestation of His divine presence and attributes, showcasing His magnificence, power, and holiness. It is central to understanding who God is and is often expressed through creation, worship, and the actions of believers reflecting His greatness.]

Psalms 19:1 ^{NASB}

“The **heavens** tell of the glory of God; and their expanse **declares** [demonstrates, exhibits, displays] the work of His hands.”

The distance from Orlando to New York is about **1,000 miles**. The moon is about **240,000 miles** from earth. It takes about 3 days for a spacecraft to reach the moon. The distance to the sun is **39 million miles, or 39 thousand-thousand miles**, and is called **1 astronomical unit**. It takes light from the sun 8 minutes to reach us. Neptune, the outmost planet is about **30 au** from the sun. The closest star to our sun is Proxima Centauri, about **270,000 au**, or **4 light years** away from us. Our galaxy is about **100,000 light years** across. (“The HEAVENS display....”)

Luke 1:37 ^{ESV} [OMNIPOTENCE – God possess all power]

“For nothing will be **impossible** with God!”

Psalms 139:2-4 ^{ESV} [OMNISCIENCE – God knows all things, including our thoughts]

“You know when I sit down and when I rise up; You **discern** my thoughts from afar. You search out my path and my lying down and are **acquainted** with all my ways. Even before a word is on my tongue, behold, O Lord, You know it altogether.”

Psalms 139:7-8 ^{VOICE} [OMNIPRESENCE – God is present everywhere]

“Can I go anywhere apart from Your Spirit? Is there anywhere I can go to **escape** Your watchful presence? If I go up into heaven, You are there. If I make my bed in the realm of the dead, You are there.”

The word “absolute” in Webster’s Dictionary, “absolute” comes from the two Latin words *ab* (“from”) and *solvere* (“to set free”) from which we also get the word dissolve. So absolute means “to be set free.” To be absolute is to be free from any kind of error, admixture, imperfection, or limit.

God is the ULTIMATE absolute – without limit, qualification, or restriction.

Micah 6:7-8 ^{NLT}

“Should we offer him thousands of rams and ten thousand rivers of olive oil? Should we **sacrifice** our firstborn children to pay for our sins? No, O people, the Lord has told you what is **good**, and this is what He requires of you: to do what is right, to love **mercy**, and to walk **humbly** with your God.”
