# BOLD



## Psalm 138:3 AMP

“On the day I called, You answered me; and You made me bold and **confident** with [renewed] strength in my life.”

## 2 Samuel 23:20-21 NLT

“There was also Benaiah son of Jehoiada, a valiant warrior from Kabzeel. He did many **heroic** deeds, which included killing two champions of Moab. Another time, on a **snowy** day, he chased a lion down into a pit and killed it. He also killed an Egyptian, a huge man [5 cubits tall]. Although the Egyptian had a spear in his hand, Benaiah went against him with a **club**, snatched the spear from his hand, and killed the Egyptian with his own spear.

## Acts 3:16 ERV

“This crippled man was healed because we **trusted** in Jesus. It was Jesus' **power** that made him well. You can see this man, and you know him. He was made completely well because of his **faith** in Jesus. You all saw it happen!”

## Acts 3:17 NLT

“Brothers, I realize that what you and your leaders did to Jesus was done in **ignorance**. But God was fulfilling what all the prophets had foretold about the Messiah—that He must **suffer** these things [see Isaiah 53]. Now repent of your sins and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped away. Then times of **refreshment** will come from the presence of the Lord, and He will again send you Jesus, your appointed Messiah.”

## Acts 4:5-7,12-14 CSB

“The next day, their rulers, elders, and scribes **assembled** in Jerusalem with Annas the high priest, Caiaphas, John, Alexander, and all the **members** of the high-priestly family. After they had Peter and John stand before them, they began to question them:  
“By what power or in what name have you done this?”

[Peter] “There is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to people by which we must be saved.” When they **observed** the boldness of Peter and John and realized that they were uneducated and untrained men, they were amazed and recognized that they had been with Jesus. And since they saw the man who had been healed standing with them, they had **nothing** to say in opposition.”

## Acts 4:29 CSB

“And now, Lord, consider their threats, and **grant** that Your servants may speak Your Word with all boldness!”

## Acts 4:31 NLT

“After this prayer, the meeting place **SHOOK**, and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit. Then they preached the **Word** of God with boldness.”

## 2 Corinthians 3:7-12 NLT

“The old way, with **laws** etched in stone, led to death, though it began with such glory that the people of Israel could not bear to look at Moses' face. For his face **shone** with the glory of God, even though the brightness was already fading away. Shouldn't we expect far greater glory under the **new** way, now that the Holy Spirit is giving life? If the old way, which brings **condemnation**, was glorious, how much more glorious is the new way, which makes us **right** with God! In fact, that first glory was not glorious at all compared with the **overwhelming** glory of the new way. So if the old way, which has been replaced, was glorious, how much more glorious is the new, which remains **forever**! Since this new way gives us such **confidence**, we can be very bold.”
