A Happy Family Reunification



Recently **Gaspar**, our Social Worker in Iringa, shared the successful and **happy reunification** of a FISCH Child with her mother and grandmother. **Anna*** was registered with FISCH in Jan, 2023, after her brother, **Samuel*** informed FISCH his sister Anna was living in a room with minimal facilities and no guardianship. Samuel had decided to leave home and **live on the Streets of Iringa**, before being registered with FISCH. Samuel took members of the FISCH Team to **visit Anna**, who was invited to register at FISCH. She has since been supported through education. **Counselling** between Anna, Samuel and their mother and grandmother took place, culminating in **Anna returning home** to her family in their home village.



Gaspar and Anna were warmly received by her family and the village government representative and were congratulated and thanked for bringing Anna safely home and for nurturing and supporting her over the last three years. They urged FISCH to **continue the good ministry** to the Street Children of Iringa.
