### Code Of Conduct

### JOINING THE CLUB

- By making contact with the club, parents of a new player should already have provided the club with an emergency contact number and a home address.
- It is essential that all parents/guardians read all documentation attached in this e-mail. The documentation attached to this email is also available on the club's web-site.
- Horwich RMI AFC recognise payment of the yearly membership fee and first set of monthly subs as confirmation that parents/guardians are agreeing to adhere by this Code of Conduct.

- If a player has previously been a member of another football club, all equipment/kit belonging to that club must have been returned before the Chairman of Horwich RMI AFC will authorise transfer into this club.



## Code of Conduct – Parent

### BELONGING TO THE CLUB

As a parent of a child at Horwich RMI AFC, you are committing to ensuring that your child is available at the correct dates and times with the correct equipment. In addition, the attitude and behaviours exhibited by parents can influence the attitude of the players and the reputation of the club in the community. It is important that the enjoyment of the game and the welfare of the young players are paramount at all times.

- Ensure that the days and times required for training and matches are made available and that appropriate transportation is organised.
- Players should arrive at training in suitable sportswear (Horwich RMI AFC kits are available but are not compulsory) , suitable footwear and wearing shin pads. Please ensure that they are dressed appropriately for the weather (sunny or cold) and have a full water/drinks bottle. No jewellery is permitted due to health safety concerns. For children who wear glass spectacles, only sports goggles are acceptable.
- If a child is playing at the weekend for a Horwich RMI AFC team, players should arrive at the match venue at the time specified by the club coach, in the correct and full match kit and suitable footwear for the surface being played upon. Again, no jewellery is permitted due to health safety concerns. For children who wear glass spectacles, only sports goggles are acceptable. As at training, please ensure that players are dressed appropriately for the weather (sunny or cold) and have a full water/drinks bottle
