## Code Of Conduct

As a club, we a have a responsibility to ensure that all players at the club are protected and safeguarded at all times. We also take great pride in the strong reputation that the club has developed in the local community.

Remember, you are representing Horwich RMI AFC and whilst a player at the club you are asked to behave in a manner which will not bring into disrepute yourselves, parents/carers, colleagues, team mates or the Club.

Registered players must:

- 1. Never be late for training or games, if you are delayed, inform your coach or other suitable official.
- 2. When provided wear tracksuits when travelling to games.
- 3. When provided wear tracksuits and suitable club training gear whilst attending training. (Shin Pads SHALL be worn at all training session for safety reasons)
- 4. Have suitable clean playing equipment ready for matches and training.
- 5. Jewellery must not be worn at matches or training for safety reasons.
- 6. Abide by the rules of the game.
- 7. Swearing, bullying, fighting will not be tolerated and the offending party Shall be reported to the clubs disciplinary committee & welfare office were further action may be taken.
- Players must arrive at training and games in a <u>fit state</u> to participate, any players attending in an <u>un-fit state</u> Shall be reported to the clubs disciplinary committee & welfare office were further action shall be taken.
- 9. At all times show respect to your coaches, colleagues, team mates and referees.
- 10. Treat the dressing room and training/playing areas as they would their own home, i.e. no damage to the property, all litter collected, particularly empty bottles, and placed in the appropriate bins. At training and games, it is accepted that the player will not enter the dressing areas until the appropriate time or until his coach is present.

- 11. Always report to the coach to ascertain any change in training arrangements. Please report your absence from training or games to one of your coaches.
- 12. Players must inform their coach if they are unable to attend any games no later than the Monday prior. Consideration will be given if players are unsure of the work shifts until later in the week.

Any player that does not follow this Code of conduct may result in one of the following:

- Required to apologies.
- Formal notification of poor conduct SHALL be communicated to the player's parents or carers.
- Required to attend a disciplinary meeting with their coaches and club officials.
- Receive a formal warning from the club.
- Be dropped, substituted or suspended from training and games.
- Not be selected for the team.
- Be asked to leave the club.

As Registered players for Horwich RMI AFC I have received, read and agree to abide by the valued points which are laid down in accordance with the players code of conduct.

I understand that if I do not adhere to the Code of Conduct then this will be addressed as a club disciplinary matter resulting in one of the action listed within this document.
