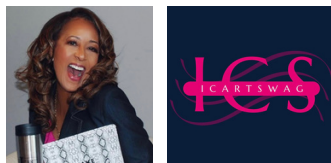


The Legacy Blue Gala will be held in Washington, DC on Saturday, May 16, 2026!

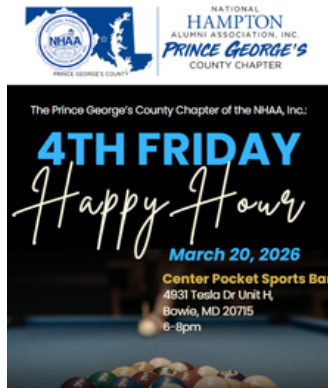
