50 YEAR MEMBER CELEBRATION

In 1970, Paula Bivens was invited to attend a Soroptimist Club meeting by her co-worker Nancy Hawes. At that time. Paula was the Youth Page editor and covered the education beat for the Anderson Herald. After that first meeting, Paula was invited to join Soroptimist membership, which at that time required a separate professional job classification for each woman. Paula served as President at separate times throughout three decades (1973-74; 1977-79; 1989-92; 1999-2001) with membership reaching 68 women in the 1970's. The projects that the club focused on in Paula's early years were to establish a downtown senior citizen center to reach people who did not have transportation to the popular Rangeline Community Center and raising funds by having a holiday style show. One year they hosted a guided tour of Whitehall, a 39-room mansion near Grandview Golf Course. That was the motivational idea for the well-known community event, the Decorator Idea House specifically to raise money for the local American Cancer Society. One year Soroptimist of Anderson gave \$10,000 to the cancer society. In her 50 years of membership in Soroptimist International of Anderson, Paula has been an active and dedicated member of the club. When she was not serving as President, she served on numerous committees and raised funds for all of our club's projects.

Mary Parsigian, a former Soroptimist International of Grosse Pointe member and Midwestern Region Governor, created the Ann Cunningham Award in May 2004 to honor Ann Cunningham's dedicated Soroptimist service. Ann joined SI of Grosse Pointe in 1978 and remained active until she died in 2016. Ann served this club as president, secretary, and director several times as well as managing many club activities. She was our Friendship Link Chair for around 25 years. She loved to dress up as Christmas Carol for our Christmas Party as well as the Positive Images party. She attended district, regional, and federation conferences while she was able. She was a Laurel Society member and was very generous at all Soroptimist levels. She loved to do the installations of officers as well as the induction of new members. She always planned these celebrations with a theme, making them more special.



The Ann Cunningham Award is presented every other year (even numbers) to a SIGP member in June at SIGP Officer Installation. The former awardee and the club president select the recipient. The following criteria is used:

Dedication to SI mission based on service to the club and projects

Helpful to club president, especially if behind the scenes

Active member as measured by attendance at club, district, regional, SIA, and SI meetings and conventions

Service as a Board member, and/or Committee Chair, Event Chair

Contributions to Program: Awards, Dream It Be It, Human Trafficking, Ghana, Grants

Participation in club service projects including Positive Images activities (tutoring, parenting program, computer lab, Christmas shopping/party, Mother's Day Bags)

Support of Fund Raising activities: Dine Around Town Raffle, Second Hand Sales, Club Crawls, and/or Mini fund raiser events

Contributions to Membership: creating/attending events, recruiting new members, hosting club events or meetings

Contributions to Public Affairs: Articles and/or photographs submitted to Newsletter, website, and/or Facebook

The third Saturday of each month Soroptimists will work at the site assisting with outdoor projects such as tending gardens and staining fences. A new indoor project is the development of a boutique for the residents to shop for clothing and accessories. On Saturday, July 18th Soroptimists met at the Catalyst Ministry offices for their orientation (see picture in front of offices). After orientation and signing releases SI members were led to the secure location for "The Farm" where they cleaned up a butterfly garden (see picture_, stained gate/fencing (see picture), and moved clothing in the boutique (see picture).

It has been a short club year but we had helped our community in numerous ways.

Oct.- Eliminating Sexual Violence -Speaker from Resilience

12 Bags of gently used bras were donated to the Free the Girls micro-enterprise programs

Nov.- Hosted <u>Days for Girls</u> **workshop-** Members provided dinner and assisted in making the items for the kits. Our members donated underwear, washcloths, soap, and fabric.

During the Spring quarantine member JoAnne Klein assembled 100 complete kits.



Days for Girls are no longer using plastic bags instead they made waterproof fabric bags.

Dec.- Member attended Movie #Female Pleasure sponsored by Soroptimist of Switzerland, the story of 5 women exploring obstacles that stand in the way of **female** sexuality in the 21st century. **Celebrated at our** annual *Holiday party and Fundraiser.*

March - Presentation of Money Smart program for teens at Taft Public High School, in partnership with Wintrust Bank. Unfortunately, we were unable to present our Dream It, Be It program: Overcoming Obstacles in the Workplace, when the schools closed.

In Mid-March the world changed with the onset of the corona Virus and quarantine.

Realizing that the needs of so many were greater than before SI Chicago doubled our annual donation to Family Rescue, Domestic Violence shelter and outreach programs.

We also contacted **New Moms**, an organization that provides shelter, support and job training for new mothers. 80% of the mothers and children were homeless.

We donated toiletries, clothing, toys, towels, copy paper, pens and a laptop for a mother taking on-line education courses.

SI Chicago was unable to host the annual Education Award dinner. \$1,000 awards were sent to both winners.

Live Your Dream recipient Madethe Mdegella, is the mother of three girls. (Photo) Madethe works as an aide in a nursing home and became an essential worker on the front line.



The Virginia Wagner award recipient, Stephanie Verderame, is finishing her nursing degree at UIC. (see her note below.)

"Thank you again for this award; I will be using the funds to help pay for my summer course (my last clinical rotation!) Since federal loans don't cover summer sessions, we always have to pay for them out of pocket and this award will offset that tremendously."

Each of our programs and projects furthered the Soroptimist vision and mission. SI Chicago members have made a significant impact in the lives of Women and Girls Locally and Internationally.
