The Roundabout

It is coming and hopefully sooner than later. We have been in conversations with GDOT and Fayette County on several occasions recently and plans are at least moving. Unfortunately, the plans are moving about the pace of Woolsey traffic at 4:30 pm. We are grateful that the final plans are almost complete and that construction will begin soon. We are even more hopeful that the roundabout will resolve the traffic issues. Please be patient just a little while longer.

Tree Preservation and Conservation

The *Town of Woolsey* has begun work on a Historic Tree Preservation Ordinance. As we have all seen throughout our County and State, construction projects often take out the trees which make our land so great. Yes, new growth is planted but we still lose many of those towering hardwoods and other flowering trees. The purpose in this ordinance will be to assure that when new construction projects are undertaken, the trees in our Town will be protected. We have worked through several drafts and are close to a final plan.

Friends of Historic Woolsey

Restoration has begun on the *Historic Woolsey Church*, originally built in 1889. The building has been stabilized and a new roof has been installed. Work has begun on the interior trying to preserve as much as possible of the original wood. This is going to be a great improvement to our Town and the beautification and vitality of Woolsey's town center.

Fayette County Public Safety

You may have already noticed in driving by Fire Station 7, there is now a medic unit located in our Town. We no longer have to wait for a unit from another area to respond to us. Also, The Sheriff's Office has been regularly patrolling our roads and helping with the speeding traffic we sometimes encounter. Thanks to Sheriff Babb and Fire Chief Hill as well as all the men and women who keep us safe!
