Regular Meeting

September 8, 2025

Mayor Pro Tem Frank Carden opened the monthly meeting at 7:00 pm.

Agenda Changes

Councilman Wright requested to add landscaping to be added to the agenda. Councilman Smith seconded the motion to add it and the motion passed unanimously.

Minutes of Prior Meeting

Councilman Wright made a motion to accept the July minutes. He was seconded by Councilman Smith. Motion passed unanimously.

Financial Report

Councilman Smith made the motion to approve the August and September Financial Report. Councilman Wright seconded him. Motion passed unanimously.

Old Business

1. Transportation update – There was no meeting held this month.
2. Discussion on setting meeting with Leslie Nieber, Fayette County – Mayor Pro Tem Carden posed the questions on whether the Council wants to hold a work session or just have a discussion with her in regards to the properties in question. Additionally, would the Council all like to attend or just the Mayor and one Councilman, along with Maurice, so as to not have a quorum present? Both Councilman Wright and Councilman Smith agreed that they are just wanting the County to provide guidance, not have the County do anything. They also both agreed that the meeting can just be with the Mayor, Maurice, and one Councilman, with Councilman Smith volunteering to be the one.
3. Other - None

New Business

1. Candidate Meet and Greet – Two potential times were discussed: 2:00 p.m. on October 12th or 6:30 p.m. on October 13th. Councilman Smith will reach out to the candidates.
2. Landscaping – Councilman Wright noted that, with Fall and Winter approaching, new mulch needed to be put down. Also, the wood on the gazebo needs to be preserved. He volunteered to contact the landscapers. Councilman Smith made a motion to look into the cost of the work to be done and Councilman Wright seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
2. Other – The estimate for the repair of the cemetery fence has been received. Should be covered by driver's insurance.

With no more business to come before the Council, Councilman Wright made the motion to adjourn. He was seconded by Councilman Smith. The meeting adjourned at 7:25 p.m.
