Regular Meeting

March 10, 2025

Mayor Laggis opened the monthly meeting at 7:00 pm. Council Carden was absent. Councilman Wright said that he planned to get the newsletter out this week. It will include information about the progress of the roundabout as well as a summary of the meeting.

Minutes of Prior Meeting

Councilman Wright made a motion to accept the January minutes. He was seconded by Councilman Smith. Motion passed unanimously.

Councilman Smith made the motion to approve the February Financial Report. Councilman Wright seconded him. Motion passed unanimously.

Councilman Wright made the motion to approve the March Financial Report. Councilman Smith seconded him. Motion passed unanimously.

Old Business

1. Transportation Committee Update – Mayor Laggis reported that he had spoken to Phil Mallon. The discussions with the store have been completed and the entrance from 92 will remain open during construction. With the number of accidents that have occurred at this location, this project is becoming a higher priority. Councilman Wright noted that since emergency vehicles will have to be able to get down Hampton Rd during the construction, could they possibly close the road at the bridge, which will allow for those people who live there to not have to go miles out of the way, but will stop out of county traffic to go through. Mayor Laggis said that he will inquire about that at the next meeting. Councilman Smith asked about the sidewalks, but those are part of the project.

2. Program of Work Updates – Councilman Wright's was discussed at the beginning of the meeting. Councilman Smith still has not heard back from Mr. Ballard regarding the possible annexation and was wondering if it was time to get assistance from someone else? Decision was made to see if Mr. Ballard was ok with that. Councilman Carden was supposed to have gotten information from Maurice Ungaro in regards to the tree ordinance, but since he was not at the meeting, there was no update.

2. Other – A mention was made about a home with the back of the roof caved in and if someone was trying to live there. Mayor Laggis suggested calling Councilman Carden to see if he knew anything, and if not to check with Maurice about a possibility of doing a welfare check or condemning the house. Councilman Wright asked if we had anything about abandoned structures and the Mayor answered by saying that he will speak to Maurice.

New Business

1. Election IGA – Councilman Wright made a motion to approve the IGA For Fayette County to run our 2025 Municipal Election. Councilman Smith seconded and motion passed unanimously.

2. Other – Mayor Laggis reported that he had attended a career day put on by the Fayette County Development Authority and the Chamber of Commerce to highlight careers that a four-year college degree is not necessary., including healthcare, construction, EMS, Trilith, etc.
