Regular Meeting

April 14, 2025

Mayor Laggis opened the monthly meeting at 7:00 pm.

Agenda Changes

Councilman Wright requested to add Municipal Summit update to the agenda. Councilman Smith made the motion to add it and he was seconded by Councilman Carden. Councilman Wright concurred and the motion passed unanimously.

Minutes of Prior Meeting

Councilman Wright made a motion to accept the March minutes. He was seconded by Councilman Smith and Councilman Carden concurred. Motion passed unanimously.

Financial Report

Councilman Carden made the motion to approve the April Financial Report. Councilman Wright seconded him and Councilman Smith concurred. Motion passed unanimously.

Old Business

1. Transportation Committee Update – Mayor Laggis reported that the Transportation Committee meeting had been held in the WCC. There is a new agreement signed with the consulting firm to make the GDOT recommended changes to the roundabout. More progress should be made soon, including beginning talks with the property owners. He told the Council that local traffic, as well as emergency vehicles, will continue to be able to use Hampton Rd East during construction after Karen brought that up to the committee. He also said that the entrance to the gas station will be “cleaned up”.
2. Town Correspondence – Councilman Wright will send to newsletter to Town Clerk to send out in an email group to those who requested emails. This way the email will have a better chance of it being opened if it is from the Town’s email address. The newsletter should be sent out before the next meeting. Councilman Carden reported that he has spoken to Maurice and requested that he just change the tree ordinance from the Town of Brooks and replace Brooks with Woolsey.
3. Election Resolution – Councilman Wright made a motion to approve Resolution # 2025-04 Calling for the Municipal Election. Councilman Carden seconded him and Councilman Smith concurred. Motion passed unanimously.
4. CIE – Mayor Laggis commented that the CIE had been approved by the State and this was the transmittal resolution. Councilman Carden made a motion to approve Resolution # 2025-Councilman Smith seconded him and Councilman Wright concurred. Motion passed unanimously.
5. Municipal Summit – Councilman Wright reported back to the Council as to what was discussed at the 2025 Municipal Summit. Topics included the Headquarters for the National Soccer Teams, Falcon Field, which is the third busiest general aviation airport in the state, the ongoing construction of the displaced left turn lanes at 54/74 in Peachtree City, and updates on the Southern Conservation Trust. The old Kmart building being turned into indoor pickleball courts and new hotels in Fayetteville and Trilith were also mentioned during the Summit. Councilman Wright reported that, during the roundtable, he commented that, other than the roundabout, nothing was happening in the Town of Woolsey, which is how we like it
