Under the authority of the Federal Plant Protection Act of 2000, permission is hereby granted to the facility/individual named above subject to the following conditions:

1. Valid for shipments of soil not heat treated at the port of entry, only if a compliance agreement (PPQ Form 519) has been completed and signed.
2. To be shipped in sturdy, leak-proof, and impact resistant containers.
3. Soil must be shipped via bonded carriers (i.e. Airline cargo, Freight Forwarder, Post Office). Soil transported as personal checked baggage is not permitted.
4. **Hand Carry - Authorized** (See permit conditions)
5. To be released without treatment at the port of entry.
6. To be used only for analysis and only in the facility of the permittee, **Hawaii Analytical Laboratory, located in, Honolulu, HI 96816.**
7. No use of soil for growing purposes is authorized, including the isolation or culture of organisms imported in soil.
8. All unconsumed soil, containers and effluent is to be autoclaved, incinerated or heat treated by the permittee at the conclusion of the project as approved and prescribed by Plant Protection and Quarantine.
9. This permit authorizes shipments from all foreign sources, including Guam, Hawaii, Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands through any U.S. port of entry staffed by Customs and Border Protection Agriculture Specialists (CBPAS).
10. Permittee shall notify CBPAS at (808) 237-4650/4601 or Fax (808) 237-4652 of all shipments arriving at or through any military facility (Hickam AFB, Barbers Point NAS, Kaneohe MCBH) at least 24 hrs. prior to arrival.
