SAFETY RULES

1. Do not leave your purses or valuables in the car when dropping off/picking up your child. Child Care Centers, schools and churches are prime targets for “smash and grabs.”
2. Do not leave any children – including elementary school age – unattended in the car while dropping off/picking up your child.
3. Do not leave your car running while dropping off or picking up your child.
4. Make sure to walk students to class and ensure a staff member acknowledges the child; do not drop off in the lobby.
5. After your child has been signed out, he/she is your responsibility. Students shall not play on the playground or in any other classroom. Please hold hands with your child in the parking lot and do not send them back into school by themselves.
6. Please refrain from being on your cell phone during drop off/pick up.
7. For the safety of your child, only closed-toed shoes are allowed to be worn to school. This means no sandals, flip flops, or crocs. Water shoes are to be worn on water days and then changed to closed toed shoes after water play.
8. Staff has been instructed to report to proper authorities when they witness a child not properly restrained in car seat, booster seat or seat belt as required by Florida law.
