News

In September 2023 Jude our Projects and Fundraising co-ordinator began a 13-month Level 3 Apprenticeship in fundraising through the University of Kent. This is an investment which will in the long run give the charity a qualified fundraiser to assist with the sustainability of the charity, applying for future grant and funds, building networks and running events.

At Christmas MCK were able to distribute 144 food hampers to local schools for them to give out to families in need of some extra support during the festive season. This was made possible because of a grant from Dartford Borough Council. We were also able to support our local clients with extra Christmas goodies.

MCK held their first ever Christmas tree festival over Advent weekend. Local groups and organisations took part by decorating trees, Knockhall school choir sang festive songs on the Friday afternoon and Rob Amon led us in some carols and songs on the Sunday. It was a lovely festive weekend with a total of £630 being raised towards the ongoing work of the charity. The trees were paid for by a grant from the Ebbsfleet Garden City Trust Community fund.

MCK is generously supported by individuals who give financially as well as local organisations, businesses and grant trusts. We are very grateful for everyone's support. We were fortunate to recently receive just over £8,000 from Beaverbrooks the Jewellers at Bluewater, a £5000 grant from the Colyer Ferguson Charitable trust and a grant of nearly £20000 from the National Lottery Community Organisations Cost of Living Fund which will support our Food Bank and Legal work amongst others.
