1. Stewardship

2. Integrity

(Proverbs 10:9, 2 Corinthians 8:21)

3. Servant Leadership

Lead by serving others and putting their needs before your own.
(Mark 10:45, Philippians 2:3-4)

4. Justice & Fairness

Treat others with equity and uphold righteousness in every transaction.
(Proverbs 21:3, Micah 6:8)

5. Diligence

Work hard and faithfully, knowing God honors excellence.
(Proverbs 22:29, Ecclesiastes 9:10)

6. Generosity

Bless others with your resources, knowing that giving honors God.
(2 Corinthians 9:6-8, Proverbs 11:25)

7. Accountability

Surround yourself with wise counsel and live transparently.
(Proverbs 27:17, James 5:16)

8. Humility

Recognize your dependence on God and value others above yourself.
(Proverbs 22:4, Philippians 2:3)

9. Wisdom

Seek God's wisdom in every decision, not just human logic.
(James 1:5, Proverbs 3:5-6)

10. Faithfulness

Be trustworthy in small things and consistent in your commitments.
(Luke 16:10, 1 Corinthians 4:2)
