



**EDUCATION:**

Bachelor's Degree (preferred) in Social Worker or related field from an accredited college. Minimum Associate's Degree in Human Services or related field with experience equivalent to two years full-time social work and/or child protection field.

**EXPERIENCES:**

One year experience with Child Protection services required.

**WORKING RELATIONSHIPS:**

Works closely with the Fort Belknap Community and other Social Services Agencies, Law Enforcement, Family Court, Child Protection Team, ICWA Committee and Foster Care Review Committee

**SPECIAL CONDITIONS:**

1. Possess a valid State of Montana Driver's License and be eligible at ordinary cost for inclusion with the Tribal Master Insurance Policy and Private Insurance.
2. Submit and pass a thorough background check. Please note: if you have already completed a background check in the last year, it can be included with the application; the Human Resources office will arrange its own background check shortly after hire.
3. Incumbent must have reliable transportation to get to and from work.

5. Breach of confidentiality will be cause for immediate release of employment.
6. Must be physically fit, able to lift 30 pounds, able to transport children.
