marriage.

Before Filing:

You must pay the filing fee at the Tribal Finance Department and get a

copy of the receipt, and you provide the clerk with the addresses of every

person who has an interest in the matter. NO EXCEPTIONS!

Procedure:

Once the co-petitioner(s) file, the clerk will set the time and place for the

hearing.

Petition:

The Court will keep the original documents and will give the Co-

petitioner(s) copies of everything that is filed.

Filing Fee:

Only Elders (55 and older) do not have to pay fees.

The cost of this petition is \$150.00. Fee waivers are not available for anyone else. All non-elders must pay at the Tribal Finance Department and submit their receipt along with the petition before the clerk can accept

and process any paperwork. The paid fee is required for all petitions.

Note:

The Court will not accept any petition until the petition is complete.

Meaning, all of the documentation and information needed are produced

and fees are paid.
