RE: Establishment of ad hoc American Rescue Plan Steering Committee

Pursuant to the authority vested in me by Article I, Section I of the Bylaws of the Fort Belknap Indian Community, I hereby establish an ad hoc American Rescue Plan Steering Committee of the Fort Belknap Indian Community Council. This Steering Committee shall be empowered to direct and manage professional staff and Tribal entity resources to assist the Council in strategic planning, decisioning, communications, and action plans with a view to maximizing the pandemic relief sources available to the Assiniboine and Gros Ventre Tribes of the Fort Belknap Indian Reservation, and to further maximize the benefit of those resources for future generations.

The Steering Committee shall be co-chaired by Councilmen Mike Fox and Dominic Messerly. Councilwoman Judy King, Councilman Tracy Ching King, Councilman Donald Horn, and Councilman Warren Morin shall also be members of the Steering Committee.

The Steering Committee shall have the authority and discretion to appoint staff, professionals and others to assist them on the following Subcommittees covering at least the following subject-matters:

- PUBLIC HEALTH
 - BEHAVIORAL HEALTH
 - SUICIDE / MMIW
 - CULTURE / YOUTH
 - EDUCATION
- GOVERNMENT SERVICES
 - PUBLIC SAFETY
 - TRANSPORTATION
 - EMS / ESSENTIAL EMPLOYEES
 - TRIBAL COURT
- INFRASTRUCTURE
 - HOUSING
 - LAND
 - ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT
- POLICY
 - STRATEGIC PLAN
 - PRIORITIES
 - ACTION AND COMMUNICATION PLAN
 - HUMAN RESOURCES
 - TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE
