The terms of this Order shall be effective for 30 days unless terminated earlier by another Court Order or unless the Petitioner/Protected Person requests a hearing.
NOTICE AND WARNING TO RESPONDENT: The Respondent be advised, as required by Title V Part XI, 19, of the following, a violation of an order of protection is a Class 2 offense punishable by imprisonment for up to six (6) months or fine of up to \$500 or both. The Respondent is forbidden to enter or stay at the petitioner's/protected person's residence, even if invited to do so by the petitioner/protected person or any other person; in no event is the order of protection voided. A peace officer must arrest without warrant and take into custody a person whom the peace officer has probably caused to believe has violated an order or protection. The Respondent may also be subject to State and Federal criminal and civil liabilities for violating this Order of Protection if the respondent is within Federal jurisdiction or the jurisdiction of another State at the time of the violation of the Order of Protection.
Pursuant to Title V, Part 9 F.P.A. Sec. 9(c), upon request of the Petitioner, a full hearing shall be set not later than seven days from the issuance of the Ex-Parte Order of Protection. If the Petitioner does not request a full hearing at the time of filing, the Respondent may request a full hearing upon the receipt of the Ex-Parte Order of Protection. If the Respondent requests a hearing it shall be set not later than ten days or earlier than eight days upon receipt. If neither party requests a hearing, the Ex-Parte Order of Protection will remain in effect as it so reads.
<u>Findings</u>
(Initial All That Apply)
1. Respondent is restrained from the Petitioner/Protected Person and from committing acts of domestic violence against the Petitioner/Protected Person, minor family and/or household members; and
2. Respondent is excluded from the dwelling of the Petitioner/Protected Person and his/her family/household members including their work places, and is restrained from any contact with the Petitioner/Protected Person, personally, directly, indirectly, or through third party; and
3. Petitioner/Protected Person is awarded temporary custody of minor family and household members, including without visitation as such visitation jeopardizes the safety of the Petitioner/Protected Person and any minor family and/or household members; and
4. That both parties are restrained from transferring, encumbering, concealing, or disposing of property except in the usual course of business or for the necessities of life and to account to the Court for all such transfers, encumbrances, dispositions, and expenditures made after the Order or communicated to the party restrained in open court; and

5. Respondent shall not harass, stalk, threaten, or cause bodily injury to Petitioner/Protected Person, minor family and/or household members; and
6. Respondent must not possess or receive firearms and/or ammunition; and
7. Respondent is advised that because he/she is the subject of this Court, it is violation of Federal Law 18 U.S.C. 922(g) for him/her to ship, transport in interstate commerce, or possess in or affecting commerce, any firearms or ammunition, or to receive any firearms or ammunition which has been shipped in interstate or foreign commerce. The maximum term of imprisonment for a violation of 18 U.S.C 922(g) is 10 years; and
8. That Respondent be ordered to pay certain costs and fees such as rent, child support, expense for shelter, court costs, lost wages or any out of pocket expenses caused by abuse; and
9. That Petitioner/Protected Person be granted possession of his/her automobile, and other essential effects regardless of ownership; and
10. The Petitioner/Protected Person states there is not an existing Order of Protection in effect; and
11. The Court, order Fort Belknap Tribal Police or Process Server to immediately serve upon the Respondent an Ex-Parte Order of Protection and confiscate any firearm(s), ammunition owned, cossessed, or within the immediate access of the Respondent; and
12. That the Court, upon request of the Petitioner/Protected Person, order the Fort Belknap Tribal Police to accompany the Petitioner/Protected Person to assist in placing Petitioner/Protected Person in possession of the dwelling or residence or to obtain possession or otherwise assist in the execution of the Order of Protection; and
13. That the Judge give notice to the respondent the consequences of violations of an Order of Protection according to the Laws of the Fort Belknap Indian Community; and
14. That the Petitioner/Protected Person be granted such relief as this Court may deem just and equitable; and
15. That a No-Contact Order is in effect for both parties for the duration of this Order of Protection.
<u>Hearing</u>
Petitioner/Protected Person <b>does</b> request a full hearing to be set not later than seven days from the issuance of the Ex-Parte Order of Protection.
Petitioner/Protected Person does not request a full hearing.
