Each bid must be accompanied by a Bid Guarantee in the form of a Bid Bond from a company with an A-1 best rating, or a cashier’s check in the amount of five percent (5%) of the bid and made payable to the client address Fort Belknap Indian Community, 656 Agency Main Street, Harlem, MT 59526 which will be held as retainer and returned to contractor upon final completion of final inspection. No bid shall be withdrawn for a period of thirty (30) days after the bid opening date without the consent of the Fort Belknap Indian Community. Checks or drafts of unsuccessful bidders will be returned as soon as possible after opening and checking the bids.

Successful bidder will have bid guarantee check returned and must provide proper insurance up to one-million dollars and a Performance Bond at 100% of contract amount acceptable to the Fort Belknap Indian Community. Contractor must comply with Prevailing Wage Act and TERO requirements.

Each contractor is to submit their bid as indicated within the proposal packet.

The Fort Belknap Indian Community reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informality in bidding.

Award of Contract: The Fort Belknap Indian Community Council will make the final award of the proposal or contract.
