

PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

Buzzsaw Wrestling Club is dedicated to creating a positive environment that develops hard-working athletes with an **effort-based mentality** rather than focusing only on outcomes. To support this mission, we ask all parents and guardians to abide by the following code of conduct:

PARENT EXPECTATIONS DURING PRACTICE

- Parents must remain in the designated parent areas (upstairs or in the front office).
- Parents are also welcome to drop their children off for practice and return at the end (preferred).
- Parents should not enter the wrestling practice area unless invited by a coach or staff member.
- Disruptions during practice are not allowed. If a wrestler continues to be disruptive after a warning, parents will be notified and they will be asked to sit out.
- Siblings are expected to remain in designated parent areas and must be supervised by their parent/guardian at all times to avoid disruptions at practice.

PARENT EXPECTATIONS DURING TOURNAMENTS

- Only credentialed coaches with a valid USA wrestling coaching card are allowed on the competition floor.
- Parents should encourage their wrestler and all Buzzsaw athletes by maintaining a positive, supportive presence.

CONDUCT AND SPORTSMANSHIP

- Parents must conduct themselves in a respectful, mature manner at all times.
- Unsportsmanlike behavior—including arguing with referees, negative comments toward athletes, coaches or officials—will not be tolerated.
- Remember: your attitude reflects directly on Buzzsaw Wrestling Club.
- Support the club's values by praising effort, hard work, and sportsmanship above all else.
- Win or lose, wrestlers are required to shake their opponent's hand.
