

Day 1 Read: Matt. 4:19-20; Matt. 16:24; Prov. 3:5-6

Following Jesus isn't for the weak. It's tough. It's arduous. It's demanding. It's often unpopular. It's worth it all!

PF: Have you ever surrendered to Jesus in salvation?

Day 2 Read: Acts 2:38; Philippians 2:12; John 20:31

God's word is given to us so we can know that we have eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

PF: Lord help me as I study your word and grow in my faith.

Day 3 Read: Is. 58:6-12; Matt. 17:19-21

Fasting is not a "punishment" but rather an opportunity to grow in faith, passion, and power in God.

PF: Lord may I be connected and committed to this fast.

Day 4 Read: Hosea 10:12; 2Chron. 7:14; James 4:8

To 'revive' is to 'bring back to life' or 'awaken'. Ask God to send the rain of His Spirit on the land to break up hardened hearts and bring forth a harvest of souls and recommitted followers.

PF: Lord, I need Personal Revival!

Day 5 Read: Ps. 23:1-6

The Lord is the Shepherd of His people. He assures them, He brings peace, He gives guidance, He gives protections, and He provides for them.

PF: Praise Him for all His blessings.

Day 6 Read: 1 Cor. 12:20-27; Heb. 10:25

From the beginning God noted that it's not good for man to be alone. He gave us each other that our gifts may be used corporately to make the church an unstoppable force of good in this world.

PF: Lord, give me a passion for Your church.

Day 7 Read: Matt. 4:16-17; Matt. 9:35-38

4.7 billion people in this world are lost. A rough statistic says that 75% of our community (Whitfield Co.) is un-churched. Cry out to God for the harvest of souls and to make us workers in the field.

PF: Lord, grant me opportunities to reach the lost.

Day 8 Read: Ps. 37:23.

Nothing can fulfill and satisfy you like knowing and doing the will of the Father.

PF: Father, show me your plans for my life and help me be submissive to those.

Day 9 Read: 2 Tim. 2:15; John 1:1-14

We often say we want "a word from God". We would do well to remember that He already spoke and His words were written down. Jesus embodied His word. To know the Bible is to know Jesus.

PF: Father, give me a hunger for Your Word.

Day 10 Read: Heb. 13:20-21; Rom. 10:14-15; Jam. 3:1

A minister's call is scary. There are many demands and expectations (many unjustified) placed on the lives of not only ministers but also their family. Prayers and support are always appreciated and needed.

PF: God, help me pray daily for my pastor, his family, and the other ministering families of our church.

Day 11 Read: Eph. 5:21-26 & 33

Marriage doesn't take two people, it takes three. God must remain at the center of both spouse's lives.

PF: Holy Spirit, guard my marriage and protect us both from Satan's lies.

Day 12 Read: Is 58:6-9

Fasting isn't about what we give up but also about what God frees us from. When our hearts align with His, fasting will lead to justice, restoration, and renewed spiritual clarity

PF: Lord align my heart with your will. Break anything in me that distracts from your mission. Help me to walk in obedience and compassion.

Day 13 Read: Deut. 8:18; Ps. 119:11; 2 Tim. 2:15

Too many of us find that we are well fed on the world but malnourished in the word of God and live defeated lives as a result.

PF: Committed to success and prosperity in God's eyes.

Day 14 Read: Eph. 4:11-13; Eph. 6:1-4; 2 Tim. 2:1-7

Pray for those mentors in your faith. Pray a prayer of thankfulness for fathers, mothers, and others in the faith who have strengthened you and who help build you up.

PF: Mentors and discipleship.

Day 15 Read: Gal. 5:7; 1 Cor. 6:18; Rom. 6:12-14; Prov. 3:5-6

God's word teaches us that after salvation we are still expected to live pure lives.

PF: God, may holiness reign in my life.

Day 16 Read: 2 Cor. 5:17; Rom. 6:20-23; 2 Cor. 9:15

Lord, thank you for your gift and the change you have made in me.

PF: Help me be an example to those watching my life.

Day 17 Read: Matt. 5:16; Ps. 100:1-5

May I be a witness this day of who God is and what He has done in my life.

PF: Lord Jesus, I want to bear good fruit in my Christian walk.

Day 18 Read: Ps. 34:3-4; 2 Tim. 1:7; 1 John 4:4

When you magnify the Lord, you shrink the supposed power of the enemy.

PF: Binding Oppression and Fear.

Day 19 Read: Matt. 16:24-25

You are a consecrated holy vessel for God's use and purpose.

PF: Lord, reveal to me my calling and help me to walk in it faithfully.

Day 20 Read: John 10:27-28; 1 John 1:7

Abide in relationships that add value to your life, faithful people who build you up and help unlock new potential. We learn to be wise by walking with the wise.

PF:Right Relationships and Kingdom Connections

Day 21 Read: Psalm 10:14; Psalm 85:6

Draw a circle on the ground. Step into the circle and ask God to fix everything in the circle the way He wants it to be.

PF: Examine me, my family, my marriage, my finances, my health, my ministry. I am yours, Lord!
