Randy was the beloved life partner of our dear board member Donna and a devoted supporter of Kinsella Angels. This scholarship was created to honor Randy's passion for education, his generous spirit of sharing knowledge, and his deep commitment to faith. It supports students who share Randy's values and seeks to inspire future leaders to carry forward his legacy of kindness through service.

Key Details

- Award Amount: A \$1,000 scholarship awarded annually to one recipient.
- Eligibility:
 - **Recipient:** Must be a high school senior or enrolled in a college, university, vocational training, or other post-secondary education program for up to six years after graduation (up to age 24).
 - This scholarship is not limited to Kinsella Angels scholars.
 - A one-time award given to a deserving student who reflects Randy's character and passions.
 - **Applicable Use:** This scholarship may be applied toward any post-secondary educational expenses, including but not limited to tuition, fees, books, supplies, equipment, and costs associated with trade schools, vocational programs, certification courses, or other qualifying educational programs.
 - **Reapplication:** Applicants may reapply annually if they are not selected, but the scholarship can only be awarded once per individual.
- Announcement Timeline:
 - Applications Open: January 13 (Randy's birthday)
 - Application Closes: March 13
 - Recipient Announced: May 13
- Requirements:
 - **Passionate:** Applicant must demonstrate a passion for one or more of Randy's core values of education, sharing knowledge, and a commitment to faith.

Applicants are required to submit a 300–500-word essay, double-spaced, detailing how they have exemplified one or more of Randy's core values—education, sharing knowledge, and faith—in their own lives.
