



Al Writing Evaluation Sample - Descriptive Writing Annotation .

Original Text:

"The ocean was big and blue. The waves made sound. It was nice."

Evaluation:

GRAMMAR (4/5)

Minor plural issue in "waves made sound" \rightarrow should read "waves made sounds" \rightarrow otherwise mechanically sound.

CLARITY (1/5)

Vague references \rightarrow reader can't visualize scene \rightarrow specify which ocean, what kind of sounds, and what "nice" means to you.

TONE (1/5)

Flat and emotionless \rightarrow misses opportunity to evoke sensory experience \rightarrow use vivid, sensory language that conveys your emotional state.

STRUCTURE (1/5)

Simple repetitive syntax ("The ocean was... The waves made...") \rightarrow reads like early-stage writing \rightarrow vary sentence length and rhythm for flow.

ENGAGEMENT (1/5)

No sensory or emotional hook \Rightarrow reader remains detached \Rightarrow describe what you felt, saw, and heard to invite immersion.

Suggested Revision:

"As I sat cross-legged on my blue striped beach blanket, I was in awe of the bejeweled blue, green, and turquoise hues of the Caribbean Sea. The water was calm, lapping peacefully in gentle rhythmic waves. It was the most serene and beautiful afternoon."

Purpose:

Demonstrates my process for refining AI-generated descriptive text through sensory detail, tone elevation, and structural variation to create more immersive, emotionally resonant writing.
