Our April artist is **ROLINDA STOTTS**. Rolinda was our demo artist last year also. Do you remember drawing the candle? That was Rolinda. This month she will share ideas about marketing and building financial success as an artist .Read her biography:

I grew up on a dairy farm, where I learned to nurture life and respect nature, shaping my artistic journey.

My artwork reflects early farm experiences and my children's perspective, focusing on the essence of nature and emotions rather than literal depictions.

Family influences are evident in my painting titles. My love for Italy, sparked by my husband, inspires me to convey its rich history and beauty through my art.

I employ a unique ten-step process to create texture and age in my paintings, using oils on self-made canvases.

The tactile nature of my work encourages viewers to engage with it, embracing imperfection as a source of grace and calm. Ultimately, I feel blessed to express my experiences and emotions through art.

# Guido Frick 2026 Art Workshop

April 30 – May 2



After a very successful workshop last year, German Painter Guido Frick is coming back to Fredericksburg to teach again in the spring! Guido studied directly with Russian artist Sergei Bongart and he is one of the last, living students of Bongart who teaches the true Bongart method – creating bold and color paintings filled with emotion and vigorous brushwork. Guido limits the number of students in his workshops so that he can spend personal time with each student to help guide them through his 3-step painting process. The workshop will be held outdoors so that Guido can demonstrate how to observe and compare the nuances of color found through direct observation of nature.

Each day of the workshop will begin with a short lecture as Guido explains his painting methods. He will do a painting demonstration on day one and on day two of the workshop. He will spend individual time at the easel with each student throughout the day. Guido will be staying at the home of DK member Chris Reese during the workshop and Chris will again be hosting an “after party” at her home on the last day of the workshop (we had so much fun last year talking about our week and sharing learned experiences!)
