## MONTHLY CRITIQUE DAY

Tuesday, May 9 at the Golden Hub 1 pm.

You are invited to bring one or two paintings to the Critique Day. Fellow artists will help you see how to improve your art. It is never meant to be a negative judgement on your endeavor. Rather, it is a fresh pair of eyes seeing adjustments you can make to a work in progress. Sometimes it is a value problem, a drawing error, or a design element that could be tweaked. We are all friends, so it is not as intimidating as you are (possibly) imagining. One comment to the wise: the critique may not agree with your artistic plan for the painting, so take comments with a grain of salt! We plan to hold this on every second Tuesday.



HOLLY WHITE-GEHRT, is our guest speaker on Thursday (she is also Chris Reese's teacher at the Atelier). Chris describes the teaching method at the atelier as follows:

"In the Atelier practice, we often use an indirect approach to

painting. Like the Old Masters, we first work out the drawing, then transfer it to canvas, then make a monochromatic underpainting, and then continue painting in layers with full color."

Holly will demonstrate a type of underpainting called the "wipe-out." Her teacher Juliette Aristides would say, somewhat in jest, that this stage is "the best your painting will ever look."

Holly is the founder and instructor of the <u>Hill Country Atelier</u>, located within the Hill Country Arts Foundation in Ingram, Texas. She also teaches workshops at HCAF and at other art organizations in Texas. She formerly resided in Seattle, Washington where she taught the Part-Time Classical Atelier at Georgetown Atelier and classes at the Gage Academy.

Holly is a graduate of Gage Academy's Aristides Atelier, where she studied with Juliette Aristides, and of Georgetown Atelier, where she studied with Tenaya Sims. She also holds a BFA from Pacific Northwest College of Art, where she graduated with the Governor's Award for Thesis Work, and a BA in anthropology from the University of Texas. She began her art studies at the Aegean Center for the

Fine Arts in Paros, Greece, and continued to broaden her range of practice, including 2 years of Zen Brushwork with a master in Japan. More recently, Holly has been learning egg tempera. As always, drawing the figure from life is her foundation.
