Thursday, November 4

See you at the Historical Society Meeting Room (not the sanctuary) – look for the side entrance on the St. Mary's side of the building. **Our demonstration (watercolor artist, Kay Smith) begins at 6:30**, but try to get there at 6:00 if you need to browse through DVD's, select a free magazine, or just want to talk with your DK friends. You can turn in completed Fall Sale forms at this meeting (we extended the deadline) and you can add two more paintings to your list you have already submitted for the sale/show. Just bring the info with you.

Barbara Mauldin will have a table with sample items needed for framing your artwork. If you have any questions about framing, now is the time. She will be available for questions beginning at 6 pm.

We will have the **Fall Show and Sale** November 12, 13, 14. Remember, everyone who shows art **MUST** help with the show.

You can

- help set up the panels
- hang the show
- work at the sales table or be a greeter
- do a demo on Saturday...

Everyone has to help take it down, and we all bring a snack for the reception.

Set up is Thursday beginning at 1 p.m.

Turn in your art and biography (1 page on white card stock) plus your art identification cards on **Friday 8 – 10 a.m.** We can also display business cards next to your art. Bring them in a Ziploc bag. Turn in your food items at this time so we can bag them and ready them for display.

Minimum price –we increased the minimum price to \$200. Studio extras must be \$20 -- \$100.



KAY SMITH will be our demonstration artist in November.

Her award-winning work is included in numerous magazines and books such as *100 Ways To Paint a Still Life and Florals, Vol 2*, and *100 Ways to Paint People and Figures Vol 2*. She has attained signature status with Southwestern Watercolor Society, Texas Watercolor Society, Wyoming Watercolor Society, New Mexico Watercolor Society, Western Federation of Watercolor Societies, Society of Watercolor Artists, Watercolor Art Society, and Texas & Neighbors (Irving Art Association).

Her watercolors hang in the Texas state Capitol building in Austin, TX as well as in England, Germany, France, Netherlands, Thailand, and Australia. She teaches art in her gallery, Brushworks Studio in Big Spring For artists and those who love art, this promises to delight. A quick Google search of "Kay Smith Big Spring watercolor artist" will give you a preview of the treat in store for all of us.

The doors open at 6 pm at the Historical Society at 312 W San Antonio Street. Follow the sidewalk to the side entrance. The demonstration begins at 6:30. The meetings are free, and all are welcome.
