Bonnie Bondurant says we have about fifty members who have renewed their membership. Are you signed up?

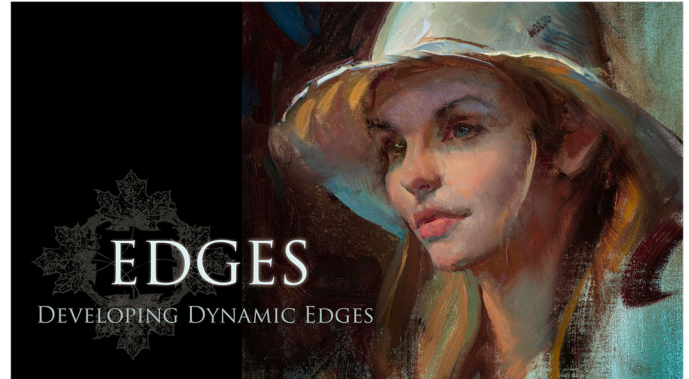
