“Armed and Dangerous” is a study of armatures (a la Edgar Payne). These will be exercises that expose you to compositional designs. There will be a brief discussion on basic armatures (S Curve, Steelyard, etc.) For this activity, copies of Payne’s thumbnail pencil sketches will be provided which illustrate various armatures. Your job will be to translate the sketch into a painting or sketch with color. You must provide your own painting materials. Any medium will do - watercolor, pastel, etc. If you work on paper, bring your own paper. We have ample table easels. We will also provide three canvas panels & odorless mineral spirits (Gamsol) for oil painters. This event is free.

Materials List: small trash bag, paper towels, pigments, brushes, palette, box for transporting wet paintings, container for solvent/water.

Creative Art Activity #3 will be in January: “Pick 3”. This is an oil painting activity. If you have no oil painting gear, contact Barbara Mauldin.

This is a basic list to get you started in the use of watercolor. As you move forward in your watercolor journey you will add to your supplies. If you already have some of these please bring what you have.

SUPPLY LIST:

- Paper 2 sheet of 140lb cold or rough press Arches watercolor paper. A full sheet 22"×30". You can get this at Hobby Lobby or order it online. We will be working on quarter sheets so 2 sheets should be plenty. If you have watercolor paper feel free to use what you have.
- Sketchbook If you have a sketchbook bring it as well. We will have practice exercises and you may want to take notes. Sketchbooks are great for this.
- Paints Please only use tube paints.

Hansa yellow	Neutral tint
Cadmium red	Sepia
Ultra-marine blue	Veridian
Cerulean blue	Chinese white
Burnt umber	Lavender (Holbien)
Yellow ochre	Cobalt teal blue

- Brushes We will be using rounds for this class. Different brands will have different sizes: Look for the largest synthetic sable you can find. I use a #12, #8, and a #4, As you move forward in the watercolor journey you will add to this
- Pallet I use a folding pallet that folds shut because I do a lot of outdoor painting. For studio work I also use a large flat pallet that seals shut. They sell little round pallets. Don't use these.
- Small Spray Bottle This is useful as well
- Easels The kind for outdoor painting, should be light, bring what you have.
- Cup for water
- Water Bottle
- Sponge
- Paper Towels / Tissues
- Seat if you don't want to stand and paint
- Board to mount your paper
- Masking Tape.

You do not have to go out and buy all new supplies for this workshop. Bring what you have. Paper is important though. Buy Arches paper for this workshop. Contact Marsha Pape for more information
