## FREDERICKSBURG THEATER COMPANY

Hi, DK artists! Please consider this a call for DK artists who would like to participate in our Spring lobby display and sale at the Fredericksburg Theater Company. The wall of art will go up on **Tuesday, February 9 at 1 pm, and be taken down on Tuesday, May 4 at 1 pm.** The display will encompass both of the regularly scheduled shows, the musical comedy "Nine to Five" and the Neil Simon comedy, "The Sunshine Boys." There are several special events that may fall during those dates, depending on the Covid 19 restrictions.

This show is open to all DK artists. We will allow the first 10 artists who respond to bring up to two original paintings a piece. You can have shown the artwork at FTC before, but think about new work, if possible. The price for wall hung art must be \$100 or more. Previous art sales have varied in subject matter and technique, from oils to pen and ink with watercolor. Popular subject matter includes animal, landscape, floral, and still life paintings. No collages, please. Sizes of 16 x 20 and below are best to allow more artists to participate. Sales of smaller paintings has worked better. I don't remember any sales that ever exceeded \$400.

Unframed original artwork is shown in 3 portable bins. Artists will be asked to limit the unframed artwork to 10. Paper entries must be shown in appropriate plastic display bags, to keep sticky fingers from damaging the work. Unframed artwork prices must be under \$100 and over \$20.

FTC handles any sales transaction, subtracts 25% for their administrative commission, and sends you a check!

I will email you back to let you know the status of the size of the artist group and whether we can accommodate all who wish to participate. Please let me know if you want to bring 1 or 2 paintings, and whether you want to bring unframed originals as well.

Keep those brushes wet, pencils sharpened, pastels ready, and ink flowing.....You get the idea!
