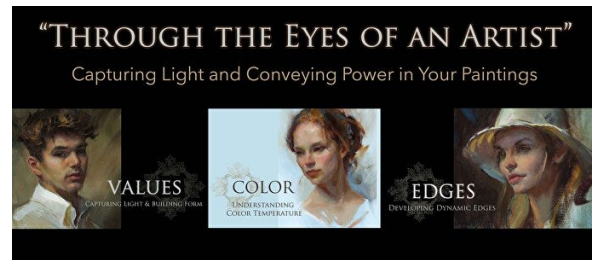

Seery - Lester Master series
Composition and Use of Light
90 mins. 1995

His work is mostly animals in the wild.

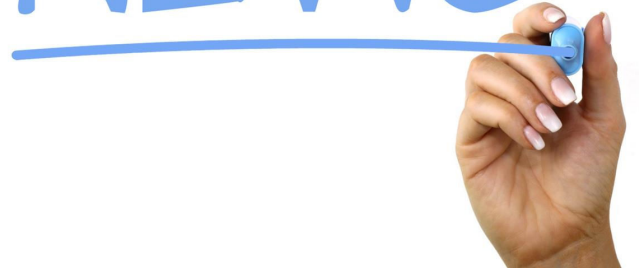
There's good info about how to achieve good proportions of dark and light to hold interest in a composition. Elements of light are also explained.

Ruby Annette is creating an Instagram page for DK.

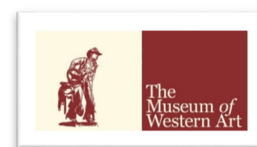
