SARA WINTERS,
an artist represented by Gallery 330, who will give a demonstration for members and guests at 6:30 p.m.

Thursday, November 3.

Winters, a native of Fredericksburg, traveled the world over, lived in Dubai, Colorado, Washington, Oklahoma and visited a number of states and countries in between.

“But nothing compares to home,” Winters said. “The Texas Hill Country influences everything I do.” Although Winters has established herself as an oil painter, she is on a new adventure creating exquisite miniature structures. With incredible detail, she builds houses, barns, and landscaping. Then she completely furnishes them, adding details such as frames, tile work, and pantries filled with canned goods.

On Nov. 3, she will demonstrate how she makes trees. Doors open at 6 p.m.

CREATIVE ART ACTIVITY

Chuck and Barbara Mauldin are hosting a special **FUN** afternoon at the Golden Hub:

"A Divided Palette"

Tuesday November 15

1pm

"A Divided Palette" will focus on color temperature. You will be provided with 3 warm colors for painting #1, 3 cool colors for painting #2, & then you use all 6 pigments for painting #3. We will work from a black and white landscape photograph. Completing these exercises helps you discover color as value. This is not a class. Barbara and Chuck are simply facilitators. The following supplies will be provided:

Oil paint (6 pigments)

Gamsol (odorless mineral spirits)

3 6x8" panels

(We will accept a donation of \$5 to cover the cost)

You bring* white oil paint, table easel, brush(es), palette knife, palette, paper towels, a container for Gamsol, a trash bag (plastic grocery bag will do), & a box to hold wet panels. Be prepared to bring home 3 wet 6x8 panels.

***IF YOU LACK ANY OF THE NECESSARY MATERIALS, do not purchase.** We can cover your needs. DK has lots of table easels, for example. Barbara & Chuck have lots of brushes...

You can sign up for this at the November meeting or you can email Barbara at this email address: mizbarb@hotmail.com. We only have room for 15 people.

If you want to use your own water soluble oil paints, contact Barbara for the list of pigments.

We hope that using a small panel will help you finish each exercise in about 40 minutes. The whole endeavor will last about 2-1/2 hours.

We are planning **Creative Art Activity #2** on Tuesday, Dec. 6: "Armed and Dangerous", a study of armatures (a la Edgar Payne). For this we will provide 3 canvas panels & copies of Payne's sketches, but you bring everything else. Any medium will do - watercolor, pastel, etc. If you work on paper, bring your own paper. This is totally free.

Creative Art Activity #3 will be in January: "Pick 3". This is an oil painting activity. If you have no oil painting gear, contact Barbara Mauldin
