Kathy Lux is our art sharing person this month on January 16 at 1 pm. She will talk about her Camera Lucida.


The camera lucida projects an optical superimposition of the subject being viewed, onto the surface upon which the artist

is drawing. The artist sees both scene and drawing surface simultaneously, as in a photographic double exposure. This allows the artist to duplicate key points of the scene on the drawing surface, thus aiding in the accurate rendering of perspective.


