MINI ART WORKSHOP ANNOUNCEMENT!

The fabulous Maren Phillips is back to teach in our art classroom at The AgriCultural Museum & Arts Center! Get Ready to Learn to use Luscious Color and Loose Watercolor Effects!

Bring 3 pieces of fruit, different or all the same. AND bring a brightly colored cloth like a tea towel or scarf or fabric scrap. Think rich strong colors that vibrate!

We will use a still life set-up as our subject but the paintings will reflect the brilliant colors and use exciting brushwork as technique. Emphasis will be on finding depth of color and richness in your mixtures.

MIXING colors will be required!

While color is the main "theme", know that painting in an abstract expressive way is encouraged (NOT required) The loose and exciting brushwork can reveal the subject without "drawing it" exactly.

Bring a small table easel or display easel on which to place your cloth. Pencil and pad for taking notes.

Introduction to Watercolor Painting -- Professional artist and instructor, Maren Phillips, will introduce participants to the wonderful, fluid art of watercolor. Class members will learn about basic watercolor supplies, and the techniques and methods used by watercolorists. Expect a mini-workshop filled with demonstrations, instruction, and fun!

What: 3-Day Workshop with Artist Cheri Christensen. Cheri is a hill country resident, represented by Insight Gallery.

Workshop Dates:

- Day 1: Thursday, Sept 21st: Start at 8:30AM for set up, with the class going from 9:00AM-12:00PM, hour lunch break then afternoon session from 1:00-4:00PM
- Day 2: Friday, Sept 22nd: Start at 8:30AM for set up, with the class going from 9:00AM-12:00PM, hour lunch break then afternoon session from 1:00-4:00PM
- Day 3: Saturday, Sept 23rd: Start at 8:30AM for set up, with the class going from 9:00AM-12:00PM, hour lunch break then afternoon session from 1:00-4:00PM
- Extra: at the end of one of the workshop days, Cheri will take anyone interested over to Insight Gallery to walk around and talk about the art on display.

Number of Participants: Maximum of 15; Minimum of 10

Cost: DK is receiving a discounted group workshop rate from Cheri Christensen. Her standard 3-day workshop is \$600.

- If DK has the minimum of 10 participants, cost will be \$400/each.
- If DK has maximum of 15 participants, cost will be \$267/each

** \$100 deposit is required to hold your place in the workshop. Deposits received first, will be the first confirmed for the workshop. Those interested in the workshop after DK has confirmed 15 participants will be placed on a waiting list if a participant must cancel.

Workshop Mediums: Oil painters preferred. Cheri will also open the workshop to acrylic painters but they need to be skilled in mixing and handling their paints.

Workshop Description: Painting Light - Oil painting in the Russian Impressionist Tradition, which can be beginner (never painted before) to any level. This workshop will focus on creating a painting with the relative use of color, value, temperature and intensity. First, Cheri will go over the basics of this approach while doing a value study. Beginners will start with the still life, more advanced students may start with photos. Using the previous knowledge on value, students will then continue working with color, with an emphasis on color hue, temperature and intensity. Cheri will discuss choice of subject, light, composition, and edges to create the kind of painting one has in mind. Students may choose any subject matter they wish.

** Note: This will be a workshop about painting light. While Cheri likes to paint animals that will not be the focus of the workshop. Cheri will work with each student one on one. The focus will be to help increase the skill level of each artist with a tried-and-true way to paint... separating light and shadow no matter the subject.
