BECKY CROUCH PATTERSON

is a fifth generation Texan, raised on her parents' ranch not far from Luckenbach. She lives on the 130-year-old Stieler Home Ranch headquarters in Comfort, Texas. Pride in her Hill Country led her to write two previous Texana best-sellers, *Hondo*, *My Father and The Ranch That Was Us*. Whether writing, painting, designing hats, boots, clothing, or making tapestries or furnishings for churches, her style always pays homage to her Texas roots, history and lifestyle.



Becky's lyrical writing about her legendary folk hero father Hondo Crouch and his Brigadoon town shows that the free thought of the 1850 German Texas "Freethinkers" was not extinguished. Spellbinding are the tragic stories of the Civil War. Vividly engaging are Luckenbach's pioneer history, and Texas-German culture. Hysterical and creative are the details of Hondo's imagination and irrepressible humor we need to cope in our man made world. And how Luckenbach – with the help of Willie, Waylon and a handful of Hondo's poet songwriter friends – was the scene that gave rise to Texas "Outlaw" music of the 70s. Luckenbach, the biggest little town in Texas, that somehow managed to rock the world.

Becky is a product of St Stephens Episcopal High School, cum laude Fine Arts major at the University of Texas, member of Pi Beta Phi sorority. Her art includes tapestries, stained glass, paintings, and more. She's had many textile tapestry solo shows. Awards: San Antonio Express News Artist of the Year, Outstanding Women of America, and Comfort Heritage Foundation Award on *The Ranch That Was Us*.

IMPORTANT LAST MINUTE REMINDERS

Labels and Display Cards: Complete and attach a label to the back of the painting. Have display card filled out and ready to be accepted at registration on Friday, November 14. A number will be assigned to the display card upon delivery. Please leave a copy of the label/registration sheet with Sales Room.

Delivery of Artwork: Friday, November 14 - 8:30–10:00 a.m. (Late delivery will not be accepted.)

Pricing: All hanging artwork must be priced above \$150. "NFS" paintings are accepted

Unframed original art:

Displayed in (1) one box that does not exceed the dimensions of: 18" (front) x 24 " (sides).

No plain brown boxes will be accepted.

Your boxes can be replenished to maintain the max. of 20 pieces.

The price, your inventory #, and artist name must appear on each piece of art.

Studio extra titles are not necessary for the sales room.

Minimum price for each painting \$25, maximum price \$150.

The artist will be responsible for tracking their inventory, as the art is not recorded, other than your inventory # on the sales receipt.

Artists must provide an updated inventory list of studio extras for the Sales Room.

Business Cards: Please bring your business cards, which will be displayed on your panel with your paintings. Business card holders will be provided.

Biographies: Provide a copy of your biography on white card stock (for display on the panel) and 6 copies for the sales table file. Include contact information. This can be in any format (8-1/2 x11"), with or without photos. Please deliver them in a file folder or file envelope on Friday with your paintings. Do not fold.
